How have the stakeholders been involved? What engagement methods have been used?	The draft policy was circulated to the full membership of the CRG and registered stakeholders for two weeks for their views, both to establish whether any amendments to the policy are required, and to understand from their perspective what the key questions to ask at consultation might be. Three responses were received from CRG-registered stakeholders (one pharmacy association, one patient group and one individual response). No responses were received from CRG members. Key response themes were as follows: (1) Several stakeholders requested for unpublished evidence to be considered in the evidence review (2) One of the respondents requested additional time for the 30 day period of public consultation (3) Additional stakeholders were identified to include in consultation (4) Stakeholders noted that an unlicenced version of Amifampridine Phosphate is in use.
