How have the stakeholders been involved? What engagement methods have been used?	The draft policy was circulated to the full membership of the CRG and registered stakeholders for one week for their views, both to establish whether any amendments to the policy are required, and to understand from their perspective what the key questions to ask at consultation might be. Two responses were received in total; one from CRG-registered stakeholders and one from CRG members. Key response themes were as follows: (1) CRG member noted that the indication termionology could be misinterpreted. PWG maintained that terminology should be consistent with the one used in the evidence review (2) Stakeholder requested changes be made in the drug admisnistration schedule of plerixafor. PWG maintained that the policy proposition should be in line with the EMA license (3) Stakeholder also identified other stakeholders which they suggested should be included in the consultation phase. PWG noted that these were already contacted as part of stakeholder testing.
What has happened or changed as a result of their input?	Stakeholders were invited to comment. See Appendix for detailed stakeholder comments. No changes made to the evidence review or policy proposition.
