How have the stakeholders been involved? What engagement methods have been used?	<p>The draft policy was circulated to the full membership of the CRG and registered stakeholders for one week for their views, both to establish whether any amendments to the policy are required, and to understand from their perspective what the key questions to ask at consultation might be.</p> <p>A total of two responses were received: two CRG members and none from CRG-registered stakeholders. Key response themes as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) British Orthopaedic Foot and Ankle Society (BOFAS) was identified as additional stakeholder</li> <li>2) A respondent requested centres be specified</li> <li>3) A respondent requested further research</li> </ol>
What has happened or changed as a result of their input?	Stakeholders were invited to comment and PWG noted that BOFAS was invited to participate in Stakeholder Testing. No updates were made to the policy proposition and evidence review.
