<p>How have the stakeholders been involved? What engagement methods have been used?</p>	<p>The draft policy was circulated to the full membership of the CRG and registered stakeholders for one week for their views, both to establish whether any amendments to the policy are required, and to understand from their perspective what the key questions to ask at consultation might be.</p> <p>Three responses were received in total: two from CRG member, and one from CRG registered stakeholders.</p> <p>Key response themes were as follows:</p> <p>(1) Additional stakeholders (British Association of Paediatric Surgeons, Children's Surgical Forum at Royal College of surgeons, Paediatric Intensive Care Society, Royal College of Nursing, British Association of Paediatric Surgeons, National Paediatric Surgeons Association) were identified to be in invited to consultation.</p> <p>(2) CRG members requested for two additional studies to be considered in the evidence review.</p> <p>(3) One of the respondents requested additional time for the 30 day period of public consultation.</p> <p>(4) Respondents noted that policy proposition needed further clarifications on availability of paediatric surgeons and other medical and nursing staff, and on required adjacent services.</p> <p>(5) Respondents requested to include lifestyle and pharmacological interventions in the policy proposition.</p> <p>(6) Stakeholder suggested to reference the NICE guidance in development 'Transition from children's to adults' services' in the policy proposition.</p>
<p>What has happened or changed as a result of their input?</p>	<p>Stakeholders were invited to comment.</p> <p>The PWG responded specifically to the following comments:</p> <p>(1) The additional identified stakeholders will be invited to comment as part of public consultation</p> <p>(2) PWG noted that one study was already included in the evidence review; and the other study was published after the evidence review was completed and does not significantly change the evidence review.</p> <p>(4) PWG noted that this will be address in the service specifications in development.</p> <p>(5) PWG noted that these interventions are covered by Tier 3 and Tier 4 services.</p> <p>(6) NICE guidance was included in sections 8 and 12 of the policy proposition.</p> <p>In summary, a minor update was made to the policy proposition. No updates were made to the evidence review.</p>
