How have stakeholders been involved? What engagement methods have been used?	Stakeholders have been involved in the policy working group. The draft policy proposition was distributed to stakeholders via email for a period of 2 weeks of stakeholder testing between 12 th and 26 th July 2019, in preparation for public consultation. Stakeholders were asked to submit their responses via email, using a standard response and in line with NHS England's standard processes for developing clinical commissioning policies.
What has happened or changed as a result of their input?	Responses were submitted by 1 stakeholder relating to IvIg monitoring in mother and baby. The response requested monitoring of the mother and baby post IvIg injection. This is already covered in the policy in the patient pathway. Therefore, there were no changes made to the policy.
How are stakeholders being kept informed of progress with policy development as a result of their input?	The policy will go to public consultation.
